



CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

New Turnaround at Delridge Way SW and 22nd Ave SW

As soon as Friday, December 5, the Seattle Department of Transportation (SDOT) will start construction at Delridge Way SW and 22nd Ave SW in the Delridge neighborhood at the request of City Councilmember Rob Saka pursuant to a budget investment passed by the Full Council. We will reconfigure the triangle at Delridge Way SW and 22nd Ave SW by building a 24-foot wide turnaround on the north side of the triangle connecting the two streets (see map). This will improve circulation for people driving in this part of the Delridge neighborhood.

Please note this project will remove the existing informal parking in this triangle and add landscaping within the triangle area south of the street segment.

When will construction happen, and how long will it take?

We will begin this work as soon as Friday, December 5. Construction is weather dependent and subject to change.

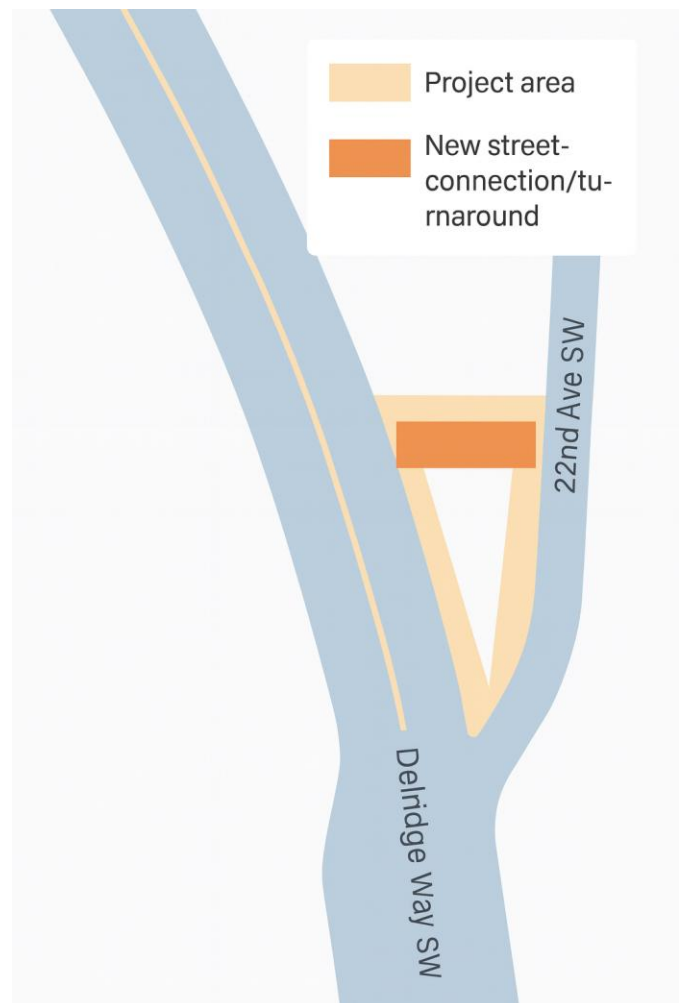
