

Project overview

What: SW Barton Street needs to be repaved - sooner rather than later

When: Beginning in April 2026

Where: Between 29th Ave SW and 26th Ave SW



Why are we doing this work?

- The street sustains damage from numerous vehicles
- Bus layover zones are prone to concrete wear-and-tear
- Exacerbation by the peat bog under the street





Bus layover zones are where buses sit when not in use to keep on schedule before the next journey.




Soil under the trees settles, the street sinks, leading to louder, bumpier rides.




We try to patch these issues as quickly as possible, but it's an ongoing issue.

Schedule

- Currently at 100% design
- January -> March 2026 - Construction contractor on-board
- **March 28, 2026 - Bus Route Service Change**
- April 2026 - Construction begins
- Fall 2026 - Construction expected to end (weather-dependent)




Bus reroutes


The changes in the following slides will begin March 28, 2026.

***The Rapid Ride C-Line & the Rt. 21 will not travel through the construction area on SW Barton St east of 35 Ave SW and will not be stopping at the Layover on SW Barton St at Roxhill Playground (South End).


Route 21 Bus Reroute



RapidRide C Bus Reroute




King County Metro Reroute Map (More Detail)

Other construction impacts

What to expect:

- Noise, dust, and vibration
- If you plan on visiting the area, know that construction will reroute you away from our construction zone (on SW Barton, between 29th Ave SW and 26th Ave SW)
- You can still get to businesses and residences, but some driveways may be closed
- You can enter Roxhill Park from 29th Ave SW or from SW Roxbury
- Westside of 25th Ave SW will be restricted for the new layover


