




NEIGHBORHOOD UPDATE – MARCH 2026

SITE SAFETY & SECURITY

Our site safety and security remains a top priority. Please be sure to take notice of the following safety measures:

- Truck deliveries will generally occur 4-5 days per week between 7:00 AM and 3:30 PM. Drivers are trained to watch out for pedestrians, but please be sure to make eye contact with them and give them plenty of room!
- Be mindful of flaggers and traffic instructions.
- Do not enter active construction areas or areas that have been secured with safety fencing.
- Obey all posted signs. The sidewalk remains closed on the east side of the site throughout construction for clearance and safety.
- Immediately report any suspicious activity or unauthorized access in construction zones to the project staff. The site is monitored by video surveillance and on-site security personnel.

DETAILS TO KNOW:

WORKING HOURS

- ✓ **Standard work hours are 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday–Friday.** However, we may need to work additional hours on the project, including at night and on weekends. In all cases, working hours will be in full compliance with City of Seattle ordinances.

NOISE AND VIBRATION

- ✓ **All activities will comply with City of Seattle noise ordinance.** Please note that backup alarms are required by Washington Industrial Safety and Health Act (WISHA) and cannot be turned off.

DELIVERIES

- ✓ **The main project delivery is from Admiral Way to 59th Street to the job site entrance on the west side of the site.**

TEMPORARY EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL (TESC)

- ✓ **The project includes controlling all stormwater per the required TESC plan to ensure only clean water leaves the site.**

ON-SITE CONDUCT

- ✓ **All employees are required to adhere to Cornerstone's and Seattle Public Schools' job site conduct policies.**
