



Details on an Upcoming Event in your Neighborhood

WHAT: Emerald City Ride

WHERE: Start and end at Railroad Park, between 1st Ave and Occidental Ave, at S Charles St

DATE(s): Saturday Apr 25, 2026 7:00am to 11:30am

TIME(s): 5:00am 1:00pm

WHO: Cascade Bicycle Club

On April 25th, Cascade Bicycle Club will be producing a special event in Railroad Park called the Emerald City Ride. This has been chosen for the start and finish of the ride because of its proximity to Hwy 99 which is how cyclists ride to the Upper West Seattle Bridge. We are thrilled to host this event in this neighborhood and it's important to us that we are communicating clearly with you.

EVENT DESCRIPTION:

A recreational bicycle ride starting and finishing at Railroad Park in the Stadium Area and using SR 99 southbound to access the upper West Seattle bridge. Riders will exit the bridge via Harbor Ave and then proceed counterclockwise around Alki Point before heading back to the start area via the lower West Seattle Bridge and the East Marginal Bike Path. The finish line will be in the same place as the start line, Railroad Park.

- Event hours are from 7AM to 11:30AM, with setup and teardown from 5:00AM to 1:00PM
- We will leave the neighborhood as we found it. All waste will be self hauled away.

- During the event hours, we expect between 2,000 to 4,000 attendees.
- We will have amplified sound during the event from 7:00-11:30AM
- Amplified sound will be in Railroad Park, to announce with use of 4 PA speakers
- Local Street Closures 5AM-12:00PM
 - Occidental Ave S, between Royal Brougham and S Charles St: Local Traffic Only
 - S Charles St, between Occidental Ave and 1st Ave: Fully Closed
- Complete Highway Closures 6:30-9:30AM
 - SB Highway 99, between Royal Brougham Exit and Spokane St Entrance
 - WB West Seattle Freeway, between 1st Ave S and 35th Ave S

We are working closely with the City of Seattle Special Events Committee to minimize the impacts of the event. Our goal is to create an enjoyable and positive experience in the neighborhood.
