West Seattle Bridge Trail closure near Delridge Way SW and West Seattle Bridge

Starting as early as Saturday, Sept. 12, Sound Transit will temporarily close a portion of the West Seattle Bridge Trail near Delridge Way SW and the West Seattle Bridge for geotechnical drilling. Crews will work for six to eight days, between 7 a.m. and 5 p.m. The on-ramp from Delridge Way SW to the West Seattle Bridge will be closed for several hours both before work begins and after work is complete to allow for the transport of equipment. Please see the maps on the following pages for the detour routes, closure areas, and work zone location.

All business and residential driveways and sidewalks near the work area will remain accessible. People are advised to travel carefully and to follow all signage. Nearby residences may hear occasional noise.

What

- West Seattle Bridge Trail closure and on-ramp closure from Delridge Way SW to West Seattle Bridge

When

- West Seattle Bridge Trail closure: Sept. 12, starting at 7 a.m. and lasting six to eight days
- Delridge Way SW on-ramp closure: Sept. 12, 7-9 a.m. and Sept. 18 before 3 p.m.
 - Contingency closure dates: Sept. 19-20, before 10 a.m. or after 3p.m.
- Work hours: 7 a.m.-5 p.m.

Where

- West Seattle Bridge Trail between 23rd Ave SW and trail intersection underneath West Seattle Bridge
- On-ramp from Delridge Way SW onto West Seattle Bridge

More

- Expect normal construction noise.
- Getting around work zones can be a challenge. Whether you are walking, rolling, cycling or driving, please stay safe by following posted signs and the crews' directions.
- Plan ahead: Leave early and allow extra time to reach your destination.
- Dates and times may change due to weather or other unexpected conditions.

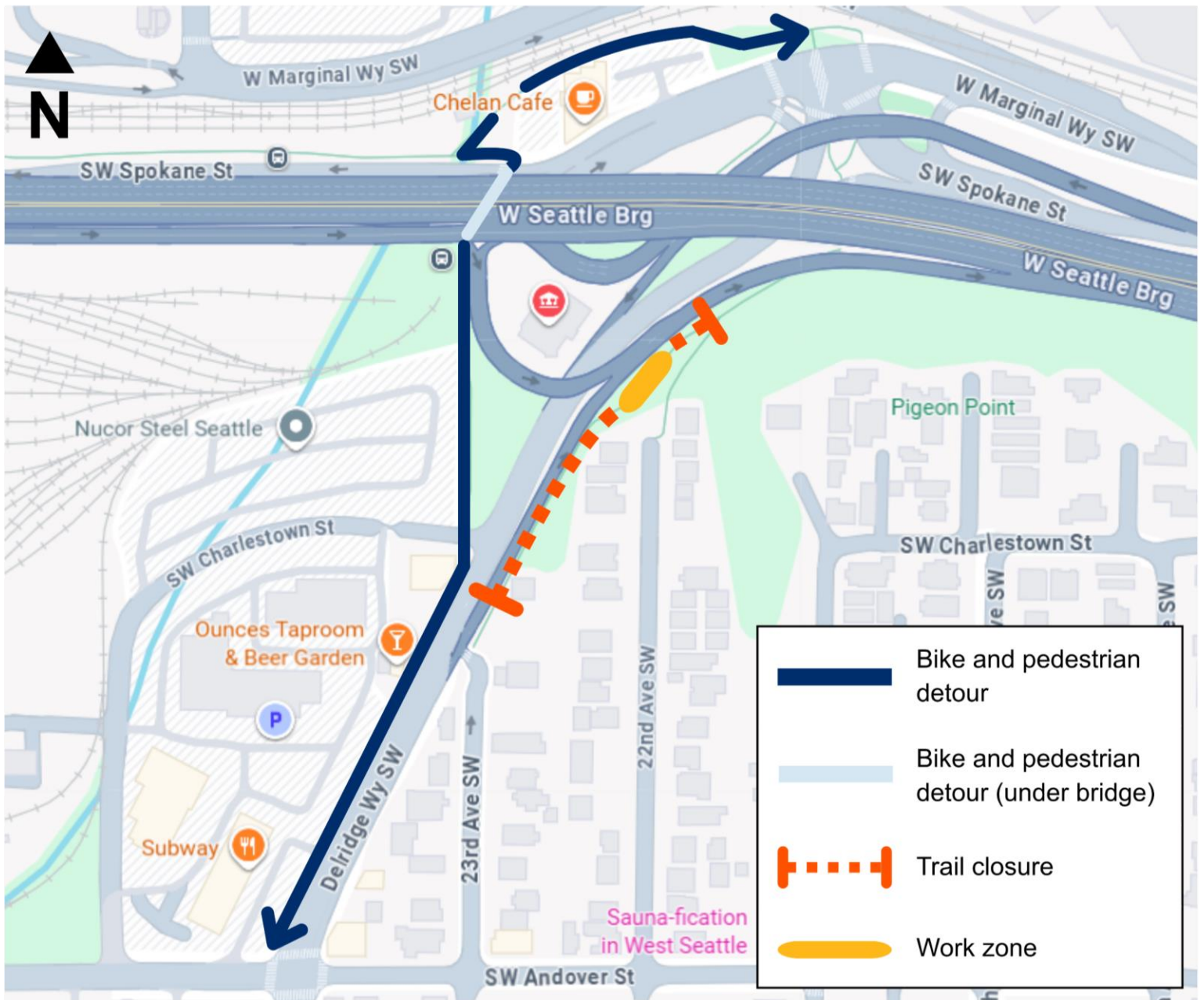

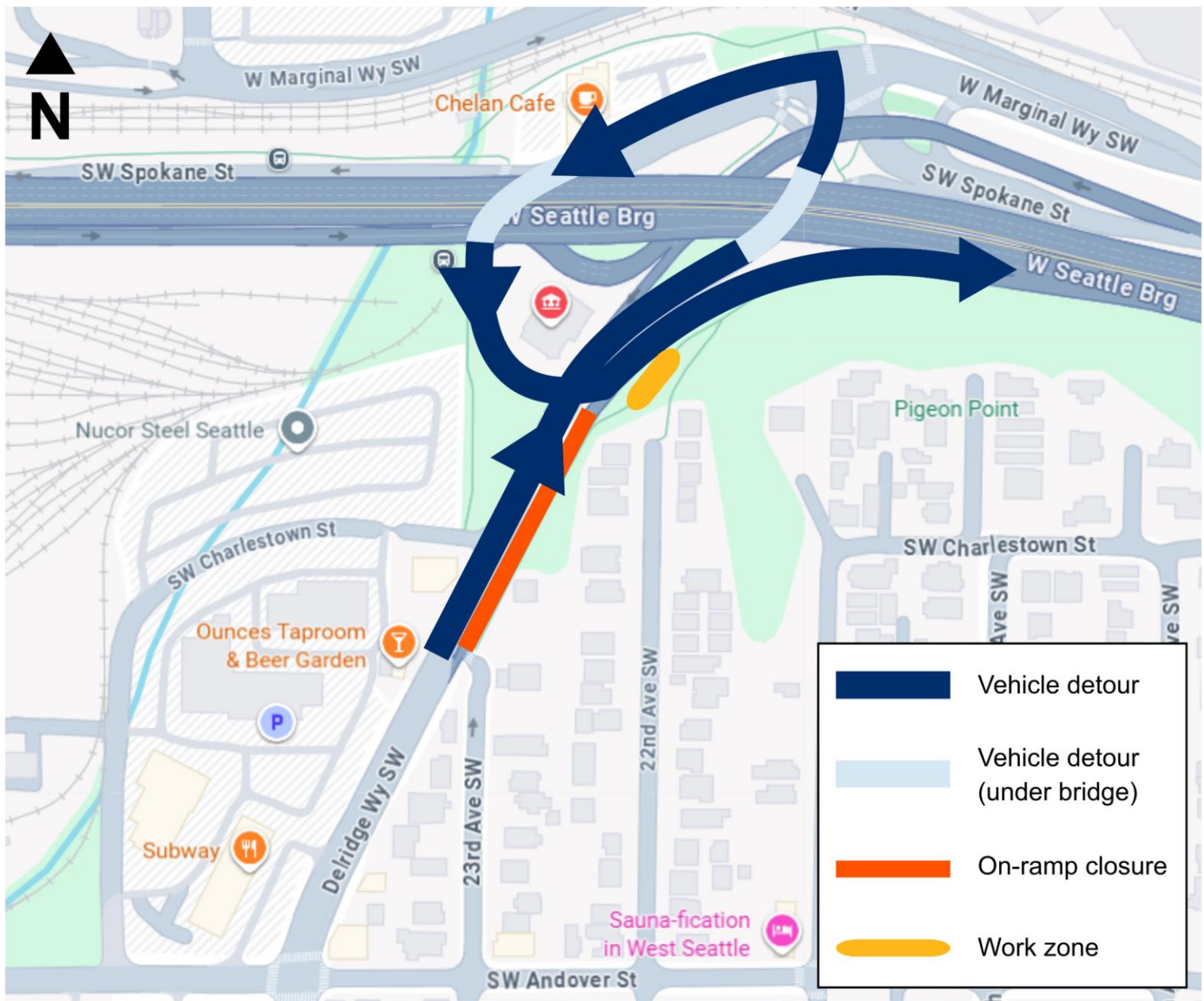
